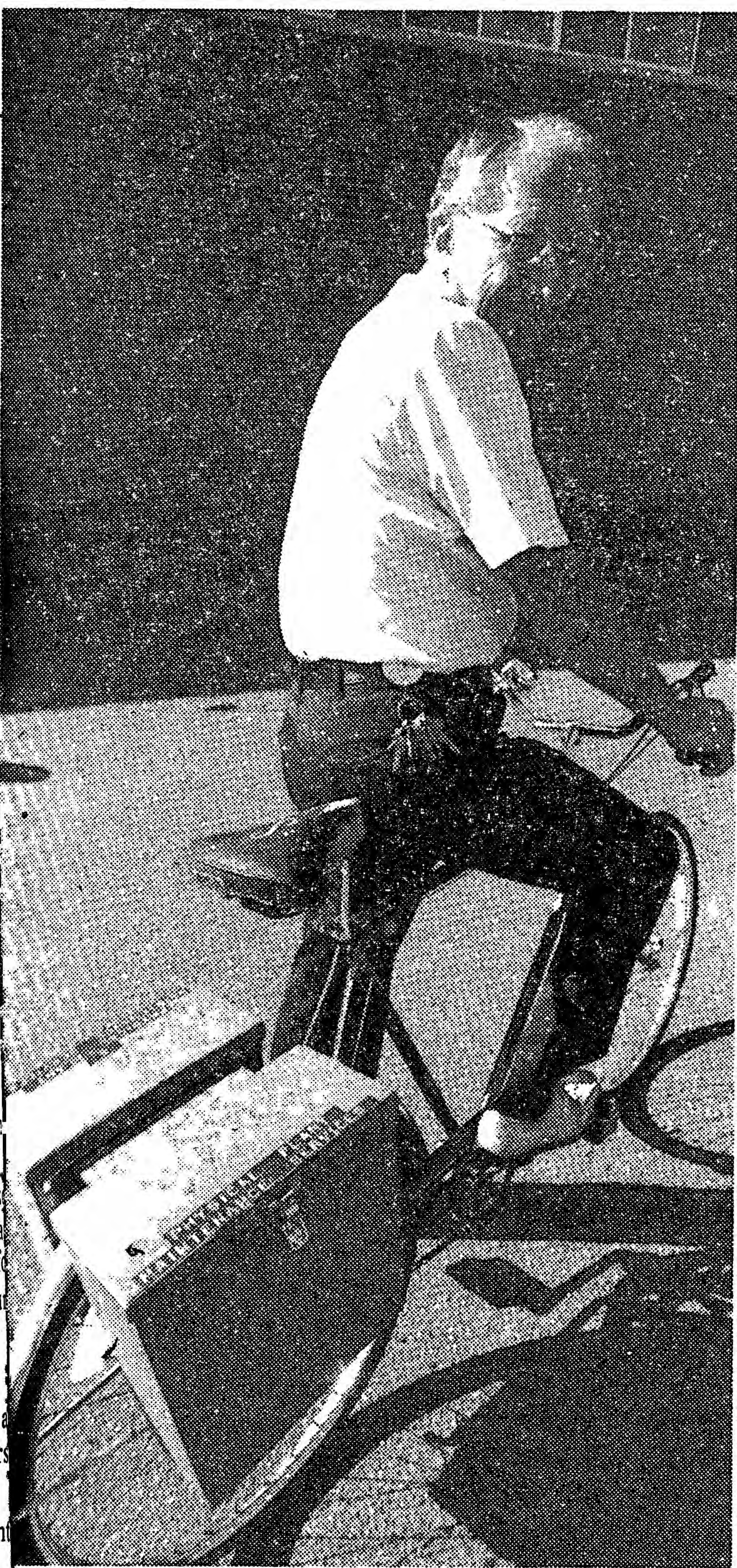

Glenn Patrick, skilled trades supervisor, is just one of a number of employees in Physical Plant Maintenance Service, who turn to "pedal power" to get around campus. Howard Smith, manager of maintenance service, says the 5-bicycle fleet was purchased a number of years ago as both a convenient and economical means of transportation. He recalls that the first year a skeptical auditor wanted to confirm that the bikes were indeed used for on-campus business. The bikes, all MSU green, are indistinguishable among the thousands of other bikes on campus except for saddlebag-type equipment carriers which bear the unit's name. D. Smith says that the bikes, which are checked out by employees just like all tools, are on the road year-round, weather permitting.
